A Job vs. a Ministry

There is a lot of truth here....

Someone has said there is a huge difference between having a job at church and having a ministry at church.

- ... If you are doing it because no one else will, it's a job. If you are doing it to serve the Lord, it's a ministry.
- ... If you're doing it just well enough to get by, it's a job. If you're doing it to the best of your ability, it's a ministry.
- ... If you'll do it only so long as it doesn't interfere with other activities, it's a job. If you're committed to staying with it even when it means letting go of other things, it's a ministry.
- ... It's hard to get excited about a job. It's almost impossible not to get excited about a ministry.

An average church is filled with people doing jobs. A great church is filled with people involved in ministry.

The Pecos River Dispatch reported recently that the population of both Iraan and McCamey had decreased since the census was last taken in 2000. The 2010 census reported what is obvious to us: there are not as many of us in our communities as there was just ten year short years ago.

I mention this to highlight an important aspect of discipleship: Anyone can claim to be a church member, but not everyone can claim to be an active member.

To be a member means more than just joining a group or sending in a check to cover the membership dues for a year. To be a member of the body of Christ means being a discipleship of Jesus – and to do that means giving of ourselves in service to the world in His name. Every church needs more disciples. Can the Lord count on you?



At FUMC – Iraan, we do fellowship right!










The March fellowship breakfast potluck will be on the 27th @ 8:30 a.m.

On June 22, 1956, a contract was signed between The Rusk Art Glass & Mirror Co. (of Grand Prairie, TX) and the First Methodist Church of McCamey. The contract called for the installation of stained glass and leaded art glass in the church sanctuary. These windows have added to the worship life of the church for nearly 55 years!

Total cost of the contract was a whopping \$1,794.00!
